■ PARTICIPANT CARDS CHILDREN'S FAIR

You can buy extra cards at the ticket office during the children's fair for €7.50 per card. With this card, children receive a free Dutch doughnut, ice cream, and a bag of popcorn.

■ GRAND OPENING

All children gather at 1:15 p.m. at the flagpole on the church square for the official opening of this children's festival. If you are there, you can win a great prize right away. So make sure you are on time. The starting signal will sound at 1:30 p.m.

■ FIRST AID

A first aid station has been set up at the kiosk on the Market Square.

■ FOR CHILDREN AGED APPROXIMATELY 3 TO 12 YEARS

Toddlers and preschoolers

The youngest children have their own scorecard and appropriate games. If you play, you earn play coins. You can exchange these coins for cool extras such as treasure hunting or testing your limits on the obstacle course. You can also have your face painted as your favorite superhero or let the street entertainer surprise you. The games are set up on and around the church square.

From grade 3

Children from grade 3 onwards receive a different points card, which allows them to participate in challenging games. This earns you play coins, known as Weuro's (Wolderse Euros). With these Weuros, you can participate in cool attractions and special games, where you can win prizes. All these games and attractions are set up on and around the Market Square.

■ LOTTERY

During the children's fair, de Vereniging Voor de Jeugd sells lottery tickets. The proceeds from the lottery are entirely earmarked for the activities that de Vereniging Voor de Jeugd organizes for the (young) residents of Waalre. Will you join in?

■ FLY THE FLAG

King's Day naturally calls for our national tricolor. Let's all fly the flag to decorate our village in a particularly festive way! Other decorations and festive clothing will also make for an extra colorful afternoon.
